

## Guided Expedition 1: Nooramunga Explorer



**Snake Island is in the heart of Nooramunga Marine Park and is the perfect destination to explore by sea kayak. This tour is available to those of good health and fitness. No experience is necessary.**

### DAY 1

<b>Kicks off</b>	Port Welshpool
<b>Camp @</b>	"The Gulf"
<b>Paddle</b>	9 km

Your Guides will get you confident and comfortable in your craft before setting off on the first leg of our journey. Snake Island, Nooramunga's biggest barrier island, is our first night's destination. We make camp at "The Gulf", a spectacular expanse of protected water and home to a trumpeting band of black swans. Explore the woodlands, which are home to koalas and kangaroos, or simply kick back with a glass of wine while your Guides prepare you a scrumptious evening meal.

### DAY 2

<b>Camp @</b>	Driftwood Camp
<b>Paddle</b>	9 km

Our day starts with a lazy morning paddle to "Driftwood Camp", on the western tip of the Island. Walk along the ocean beach, enjoy a spot of fishing or just soak up the beauty of one of the state's best kept secrets.

### DAY 3

<b>Journey's end</b>	Port Albert
<b>Paddle</b>	10 km

Our lunch spot is Drum Island, a sandy paradise and a haven for the elusive hog deer. Observe a diverse range of flora before our final leg into sleepy Port Albert, and our journey's end.
